The Port of Lowestoft

The UK's most eastern port, Lowestoft has a long history of servicing offshore energy projects and offers highly skilled teams equipped to handle a wide range of cargoes safely and efficiently. The port is owned and operated by Associated British Ports (ABP).

Having worked together for over 5 years, Peterson and ABP have developed a strong partnership and a successful track record in meeting the demands of energy majors operating in the SNS. With a focus on sustainable investment and innovation, we also continue to work together to develop the port to meet the future needs of our customers.

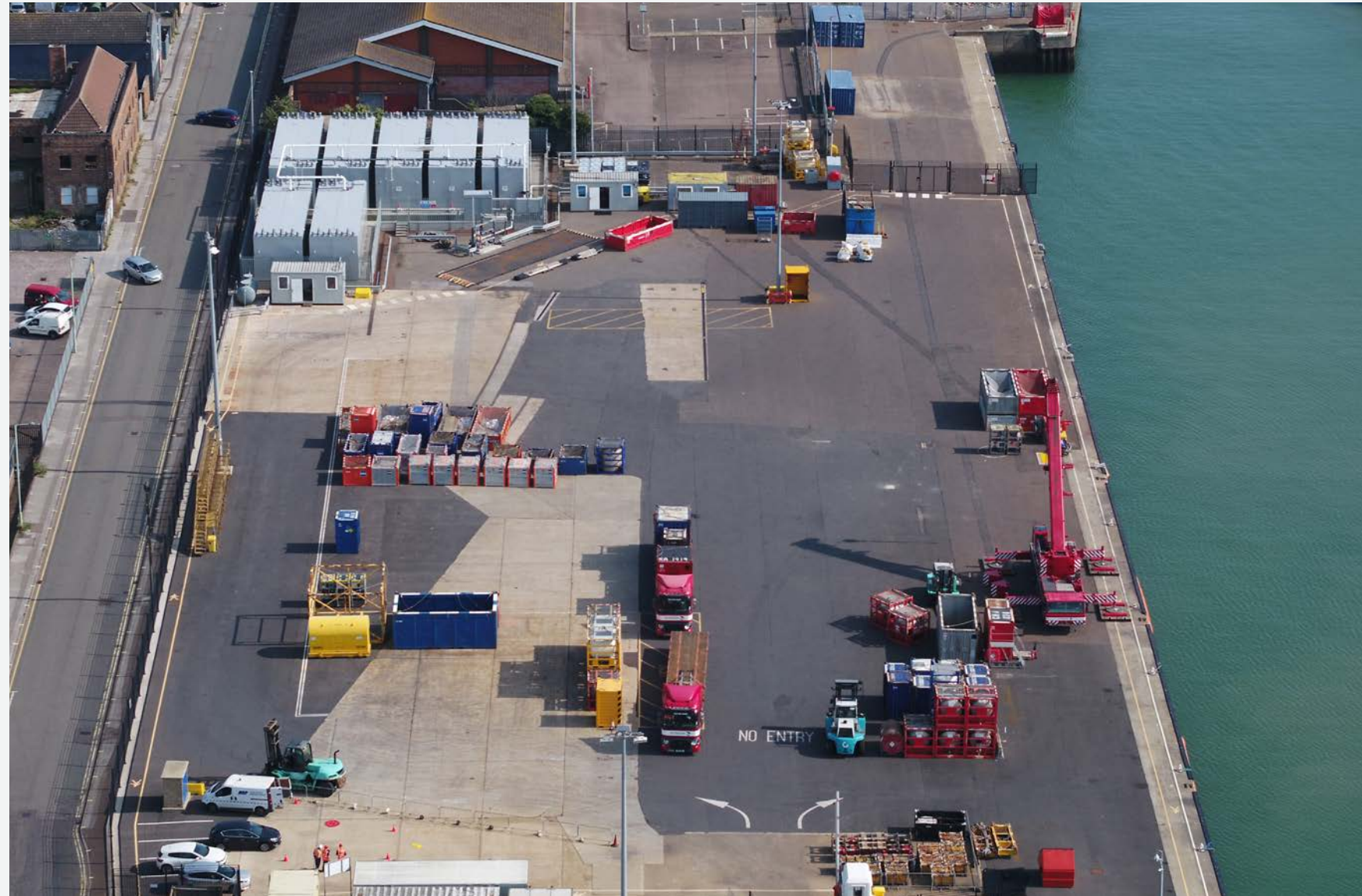


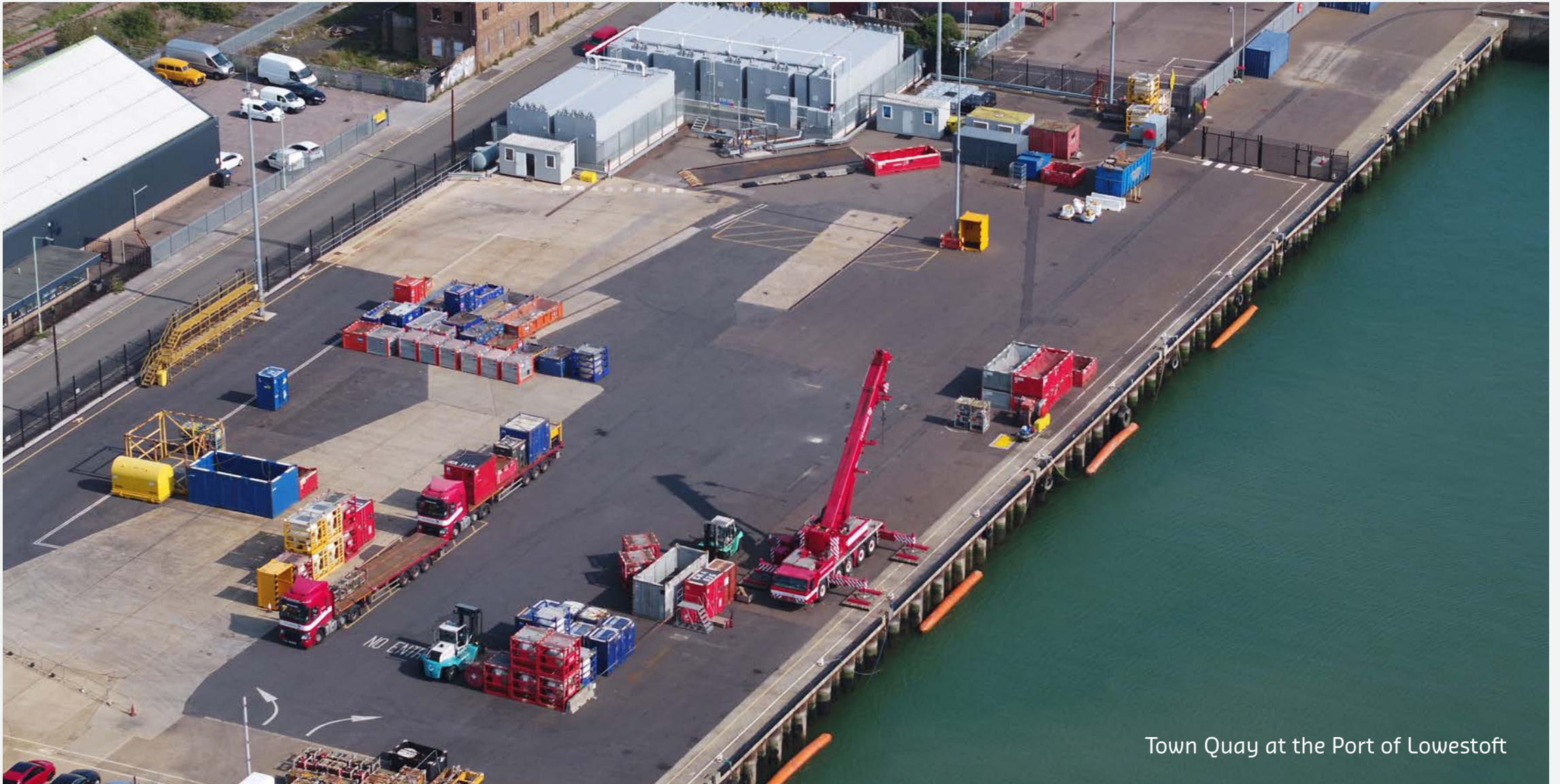
Town Quay

Our facility at Town Quay has a laydown area of 5,000m² and 140m of prime quayside accommodating 2 berths.

The 6.2m draft can accommodate Multi-Role Vessels. In brief, Town Quay can provide the following:

- + 2.7 acre footprint
- + Close to port vehicular entrance
- + Secure location
- + Inspection gantry
- + Lighting tower to cover 24/7 services
- + Designated storage area for non/hazardous waste
- + Quay depths at 6.2 meters is the deepest within the port
- + Access to water bunker (rate – up to 50t/h)
- + Fuel facility operated by Peterson (rate 100m³)





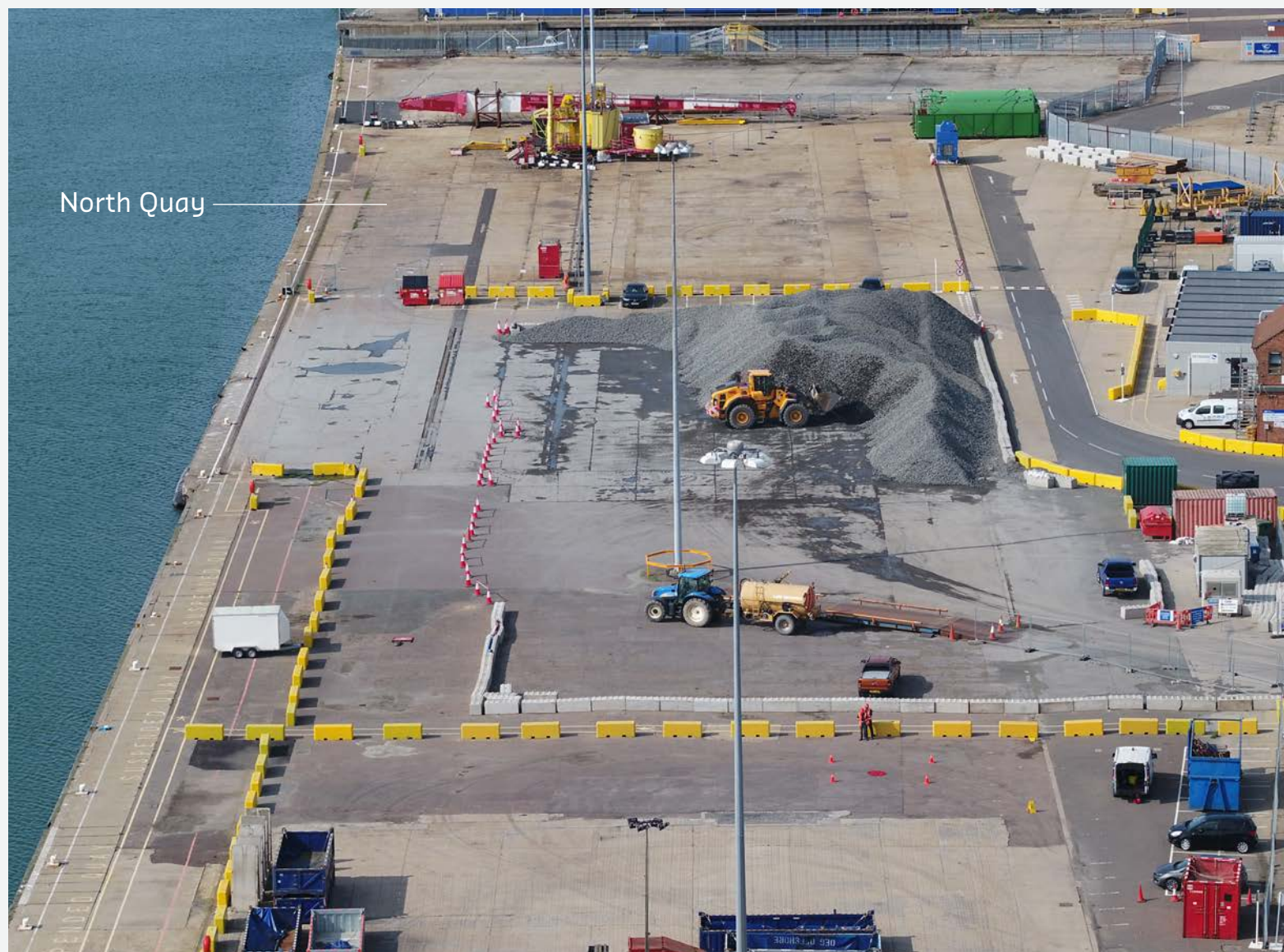
Town Quay at the Port of Lowestoft

North Quay

We also have access to other non-exclusive berths across the port, including North Quay.

North Quay is situated further along the river from Town Quay and offers more space for laydown next to the operational quayside. In brief, North Quay can provide the following:

- + Direct access to Berth 7 (80m), draft 6m
- + Preferential access to adjacent Berth 6 (70m), draft 5.7m
- + Location close to port vehicular entrance
- + Secure location
- + Only 200m away from additional quays, capable of dealing with a range of smaller craft, such as CTVs, with quay depths of 4.2 meters
- + 5,000m² of external storage adjacent to Berth 7
- + 2,000m² of internal storage within close proximity of the quayside
- + Additional storage options available in the local area, if required
- + Lighting tower to cover 24/7 services
- + Access to water bunker (rate – up to 50t/h)



**Peterson warehouse**

- + 2,500m² warehouse
- + Option to extend by 1,500m²
- + Direct access to quayside (if needed)
- + Adjacent open storage options

Lowestoft Eastern Energy Facility (LEEF)

ABP's Lowestoft Eastern Energy Facility (LEEF) delivers state-of-the-art port infrastructure to meet the offshore energy industry's current and future demands, ensuring the port can accommodate the next generation of offshore support vessels.

LEEF includes:

- + 360m quayside with 3x 7.5m draft deep water berths
- + Capability to support walk-to-work and drilling vessels
- + Fuel, water and power feed directly to the berths
- + <6 acres of operational and storage land
- + Dedicated, ISPS security-controlled entrance
- + Office space for up to 200 personnel, subject to requirements
- + Additional pilot boat and crew to provide a 'pilotage on demand' service



Quayside operations

Peterson runs quayside operations throughout the UK including the Port of Lowestoft, managing extensive warehouses, port facilities and a dedicated fleet of vehicles. We are specialists in consolidation and sharing, bringing strong capability with a long-term view and a history in industry that supports our foundation of Trust Well Placed.

- + Pre-shipment inspections, load and off loading of cargo
- + Owned and operated hardware and equipment
- + High-volume water supply at all quays
- + Specialist cargo management software - Flow
- + Ability to create deck plans together with the ship's master ensuring optimum efficiency
- + Comprehensive cargo handling services
- + Access to plant and equipment to support a range of lifting operations
- + Stevedoring and quayside services, warehousing and open storage

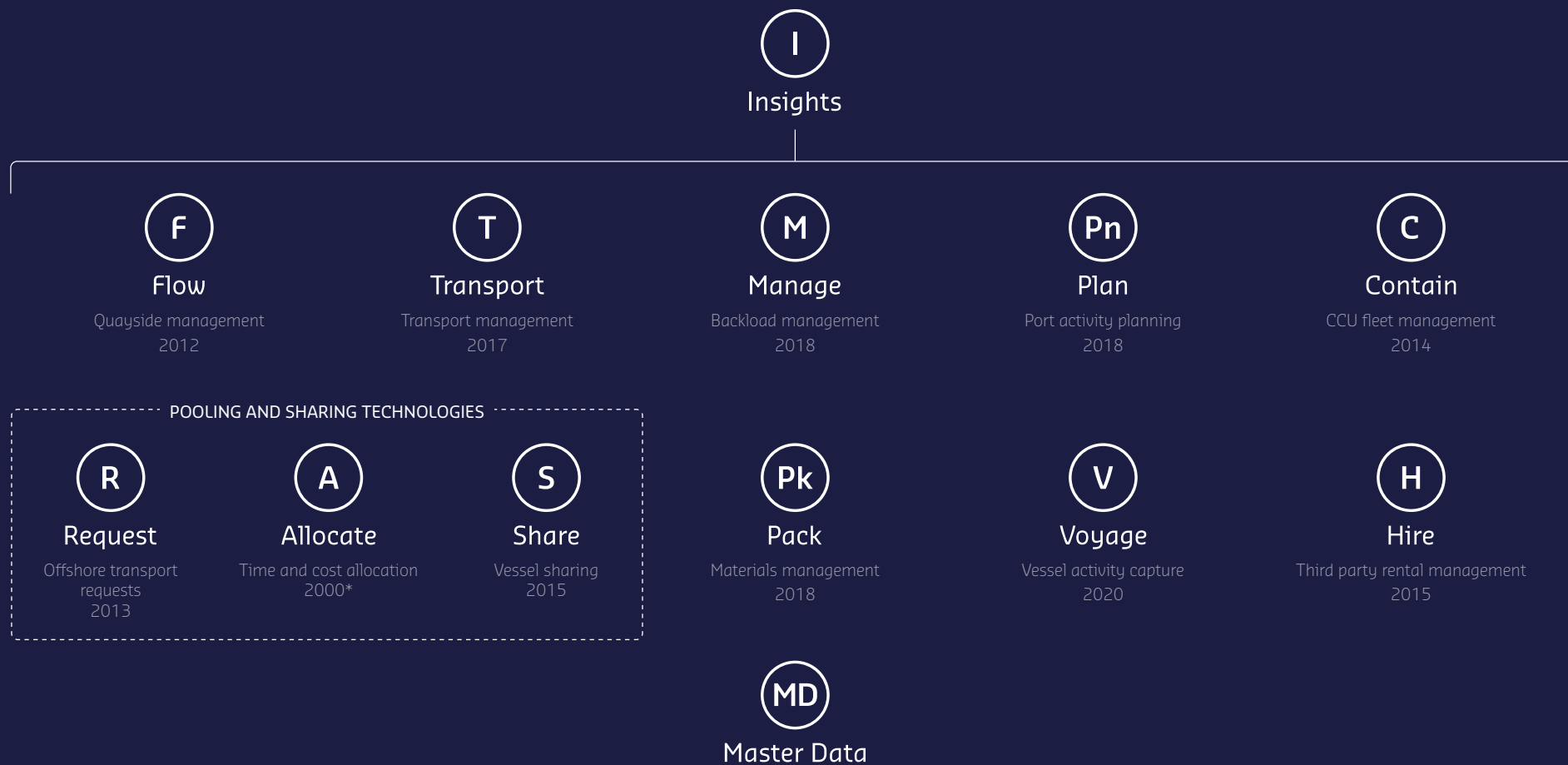

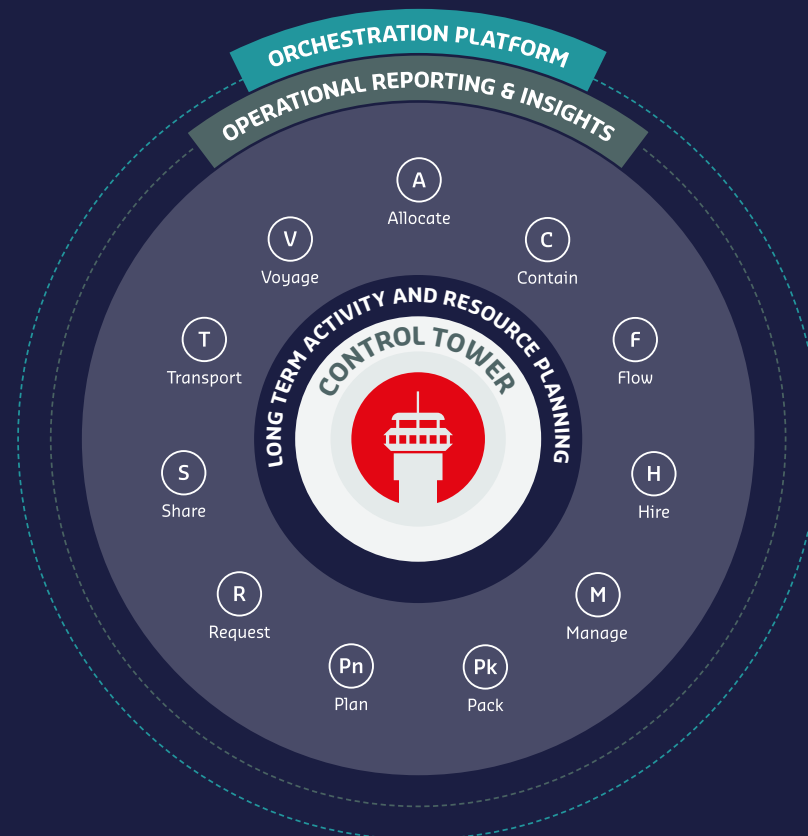

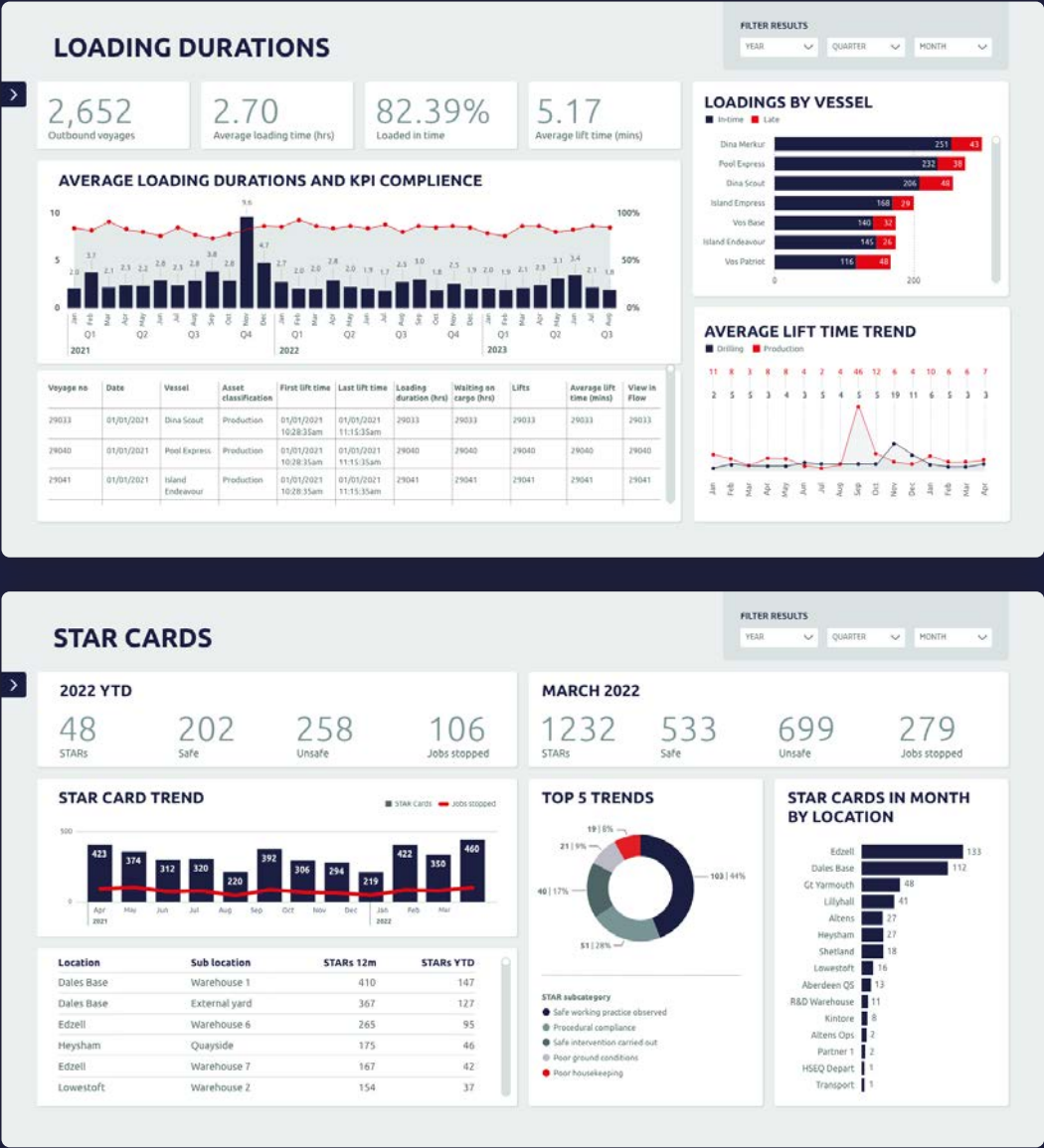
